






"Standing vrs Walking"

Standing in someone's shoes is perspective taking


Walking a mile gives you the weariness, joys, dangers of another's journey, or empathy.



Indian removal

- Began with pressure of white settlements by the late 1700s
 - Voluntary to escape conflict with white settlers and government agents
- **Continued** with the 1830 act of Congress
 - government agents carried out <u>forced removals</u>.





Americanization Policy – 1860s

- Centralizing Indians on Reservations
- Separate Indians from their traditional lands and communal living
- Eradicate Native cultures
- Civilize the Indian by
 - —Going to School
 - -Joining the Christian church
 - Learning to Farm

Boarding Schools

Some were forcibly taken from parents

Mandatory laws – through coercion

Quotas from Reservations

Persuade parents – "Best Interest"

Civilization Process

- Received Haircuts
- School uniforms
- English names
- Forbidden to speak native language
- Forbidden to practice native religion
- Forbidden to practice culture
- Military discipline strict routine


