

Polychlorinated biphenyls (PCB's)

Following are examples of materials that may contain PCB's:

- Electronic components: lighting ballasts, capacitors and transformers.
 - Lighting ballasts and capacitors can be recycled.
 - Transformers must be managed as hazardous waste.
- Industrial caulk and bituminous (bit) felt in structures built prior to 1980.
 - Greater than 50 ppm must be managed as a hazardous waste.
 - Less than or equal to 50 ppm may be managed as a solid waste.

Storage

- Store waste electronic lighting ballasts and capacitors in a sturdy cardboard box or plastic pail.
- Store waste transformers, industrial caulk, and bit felt in plastic pail or drum.
